Call for expressions of interest to host the 26th WaterNet/WARFSA/GWPSA Symposium

- 3. Organizations which will be part of the Local Organizing Committee;
- 4. Anticipated organizations which will provide support in cash and in kind;
- 5. How the event will be marketed locally and internationally;
- 6. Nature of technical support that will be required from the conveners, i.e. WaterNet, GWPSA and co-conveners.

Expressions of interest submissions from countries that have not hosted the symposium before (i.e. The Comoros, Seychelles, DR Congo and Madagascar) are strongly encouraged.
